Nature based art lowers pulse rate and brings a feeling of well-being to its viewers.

Henry Domke, M.D. explains these effects in his book “Picture of Health: Handbook for Healthcare Art”:

“Most of the “hardwired” networks in our brains were formed about 10,000 to 50,000 years ago. It takes that long for changes in the brain to pass through the evolutionary cycles that will permanently and universally implant them. During that time, we were living in primitive communities located on the savannas of the African plains. These savannas are characterized by an open meadow, perhaps with a stream of water running through the meadow, surrounded by a border of trees and open sky. This gave our ancestors the comfort of feeling that any predators lurking in the trees would be seen if they ventured into the open meadow, giving our ancestors time to flee.”
